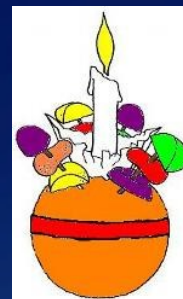

## The Sheep Trail

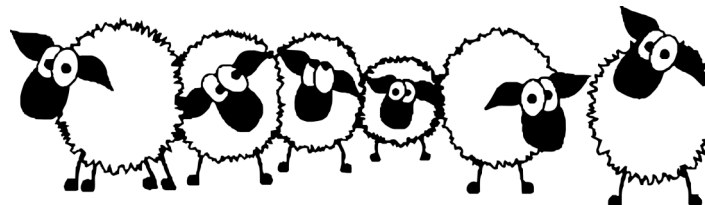
